The Spiritual Journey Brews on DVD October 11

LOS ANGELES (August 29, 2011) – Jennifer Love Hewitt (TV’s “The Ghost Whisperer,” TV Movie “The Client List,” *Can’t Hardly Wait*) and Jamie Kennedy (upcoming *Good Deeds*, *Extreme Movie*, *Kickin’ It Old School*, *Scream*) star in the ensemble indie drama **Café**, coming to DVD October 11 from Maya Entertainment. **Café** tracks a week in the life of a group of West Philadelphia residents who are dealing with life’s challenges and trying to get things right. But after misfortune strikes the community, Claire (Jennifer Love Hewitt), an employee of “West Philly Grounds,” comes to realize how much these strangers impact the lives of one another, including local drug dealer Glenn (Jamie Kennedy).

A commentary on the meaning and purpose of life – and even who may be controlling our fate – the film offers up some answers to a few of the deeper questions about our spiritual existence. Marking the directorial debut of writer/director Marc Erlbaum, **Café** also stars Daniel Eric Gold (TV’s “Ugly Betty,” *Harvest*, *Last Night*), Alexa Vega (*From Prada to Nada*, *Spy Kids*) and Madeline Carroll (*Mr. Penguins Poppers*). **Café** will be available on DVD for \$27.98 SRP.

Synopsis:

Café follows the interweaving stories of a coffee shop's regular patrons over the course of a week in West Philadelphia. The café is a local meeting spot for a group of vastly diverse people, all of whom are doing their best to deal with the personal and societal issues that engulf them. When tragedy strikes the community surrounding the café, the regular customers come to realize exactly how intertwined their lives truly are.

The debut film from Nationlight Productions, **Café** was produced by J. Andrew Greenblatt (*Everything Must Go*), Marc Erlbaum, Sean Covel (*Napoleon Dynamite*) and Chris Doc Wyatt (*Napoleon Dynamite*).

Café has a running time of 95 minutes and is not rated. The film was shot on location in Philadelphia and features a soundtrack that includes many local musicians.
